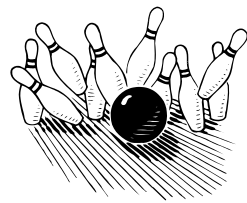

**Let Our Sanctuary Spaces Speak: Meal Space and Art “At the Table”**  
**Saturday, January 30, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM**

In this seminar, Dr. Samuel Torvend, associate professor of the history of Christianity and director of the Lilly Endowment “Program for the Theological Exploration of Vocation” at Pacific Lutheran University, will lead us in a reflection on the different meanings of the Eucharist within Lutheran and other Christian communities. At the same time, the seminar will demonstrate how these different meanings “take flesh” in the environment and art of a worship space. Finally, the seminar will lead participants to consider the questions and challenges of shaping a Eucharistic space for the church of the 21st century.

Dr. Torvend is the author of *Daily Bread, Holy Meal: Opening the Gifts of Holy Communion* (Augsburg Fortress, 2004), *Luther and the Hungry Poor* (Fortress, 2008), and the forthcoming *Living Water, Uncommon Birth: Christian Baptism in a Post-Christian World* (Augsburg Fortress, 2010), and *Still Hungry at the Feast: Preaching and Teaching the Eucharist in a Needy World* (Liturgical Press, 2010).

This is the second in a series of seminars made possible through a Worship Renewal Grant from the Calvin Institute of Christian Worship, Grand Rapids, Michigan, with funds provided by Lilly Endowment Inc.
