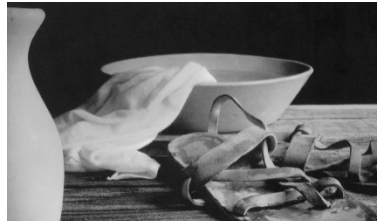

Maundy Thursday

Here we are in Holy Week. This week we will have a Maundy Thursday Service in the evening at 7:00PM. The service will include foot washing so Ladies in particular, if you would like to participate in the foot washing, it is recommended you not wear a skirt or dress and definitely, no full-length stockings. This is an important part of our walk with Jesus to the cross so please don't be shy about participating.



Good Friday

The Good Friday Service is starting at 7:30 PM on Friday March 29. This service will be quiet, contemplative, solemn, with low key Taize music and singing, candle lighting, and reflection. Our journey with Christ to the cross continues.



Easter Prayer Vigil

With a brief interlude for setting up, our path flows into the Prayer Vigil which keeps our hearts and souls grounded in the experience of these moments before the glorious resurrection of our Lord. We now have the opportunity to reflect in prayer our confessions for our sins, our lamentations for our fears, our weaknesses, our suffering, our cries for forgiveness, our intercessory prayers for friends and family, our community, our nation, our world. The Prayer vigil is a deep and powerful experience and ever the more meaningful to experience it at church. When you reserve a 1 or 2 hour time slot, you have the church all to yourself.

Get ready for this year's Easter Prayer Vigil, the 24th vigil in KLC history. There are meaningful on-line materials and prayer guides to get you started in prayer whether you come to the church to pray in the Sanctuary and Narthex or plan to stay at home for your praying time. One hour time slots are available from 9:00 PM on Friday March 29 (after the Good Friday service) all through the night and all-day Saturday until 8:00 PM.

You are asked to create a giving profile or to login to a profile you have already created. You specify what amounts you want to contribute and if you want to make recurring donations.
