The Good Friday Service is starting at 7:30 PM on Friday March 29. This service will be quiet, contemplative, solemn, with low key Taize music and singing, candle lighting, and reflection. Our



journey with Christ to the cross continues.

#### Easter Prayer Vigil

With a brief interlude for setting up, our path flows into the Prayer Vigil which keeps our hearts and souls grounded in the experience of these moments before the glorious

resurrection of our Lord. We now have the opportunity to reflect in prayer our confessions for our sins, our lamentations for our fears, our weaknesses, our suffering, our cries for forgiveness, our intercessory prayers for friends and family, our community, our nation, our world. ### **CONSTITUTION REVIEW**


