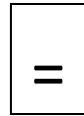

## NEW MEMBERS

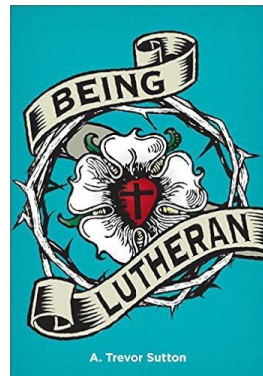
Have you been worshipping with us, but not yet an “official” member of KLC?

Pressing this button takes you to a Kent Lutheran screen on a secure server. You are asked to create a giving profile or to login to a profile you have already created. You specify what amounts you want to contribute and if you want to make recurring donations.
