## CHURCH COUNCIL UPDATE

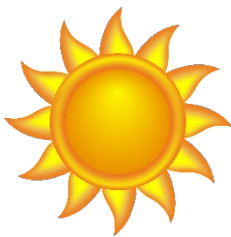
The latest Church Council meeting was on July 15, 2025, in the Fellowship Hall. The air conditioning was much appreciated! The four primary areas of conversation were budgeting for committees, the block party, the bulletin board/entry area, and solar power. Here are the highlights:

**BUDGET PROCESS/PROGRESS:** It's time to start thinking about committee budgets for next year. The committee representatives should check with Mona to determine the specific status of their respective budgets. Think about what you want to do next year and what it'll take to do it.



**BULLETIN BOARDS+:** An ad hoc committee, representing Music and Worship, Property Management, and other relevant areas, is working on the broader subject of the attractiveness and use of the entry area and narthex. This includes more than just the bulletin boards. Once they have some recommendations, they will present the ideas at a future coffee hour.

**BLOCK PARTY:** The event planning is progressing and gathering momentum. There is a good response from participants, and we could use additional volunteers. Please spread the word about this fun event!



**SOLAR POWER:** We have a group working on getting solar power installed. They have contacted three different companies. The most positive response was from SolTerra, which sent a representative to conduct measurements and fulfill other requirements to provide a cost estimate. All work is contingent on getting a grant from PSE. The size of the grant is approximately \$100,000.

# Kent Grand Organ Progress Report — July 2025

Marceau and Associates are working toward the completion of the chancel console. Pictures tell of the beautiful craftsmanship and woodwork being created. This part of the project is nearing completion. Installation date to be announced. We celebrate that this accomplishment and look forward to the final phase of our project.



As we wait for the final components for the console, a glockenspiel is born! This will eventually be installed in the chancel organ within the Swell division. The final phase of our Kent Grand Organ project will focus on the chancel area. It will include the cabinet case work for installation of all the pipes. The installation of the blower for the chancel organ. All the technical work connecting both the chancel and gallery organs with the consoles and coordination of all systems.

With tight supply-line issues because of COVID, the undependability of the American and international economy, cost has been a challenge. The KGO Board, Pastor Tormod and our organ craftsmen has been working hard with this challenge.
