All are invited. The more the merrier. There will be snacks!

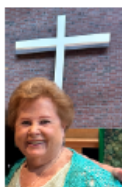

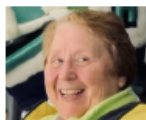

As members of our committee each of us is developing skills to truly serve as a team. Moving forward we're experimenting with new ideas and making purposeful choices hoping our entire congregation feels God's presence as we worship together. We're making spaces in worship for more quiet prayer. We're paying attention to making our entire experience conducive to prayerful participation, including ways of making our prayers and hymn inclusive, and encouraging full-hearted congregational praying and singing.

Pastor Tormod is introducing our congregation to use of the Narrative Lectionary which provides a greater focus on the story in Scripture rather than reading from a sprinkling of several books of Scripture.

We're encouraging more folks to participate in leadership roles in Worship, such as proclaiming God's Word in Scripture, leading prayer as assisting ministers, and as song leaders.

We'll provide preparation and coaching for anyone interested in sharing Worship and Music leadership roles.

There are several methods available for electronic giving:

- 2) Set up bill pay through your bank and the bank will send a check to KLC. You can set up a one-time payment or a recurring payment using this method.
- 3) Simply Giving – you fill out a form (available through the church office) and give the form and a cancelled check to our financial secretary, Kathy Nixon. Kathy enters your information and the fund transfer(s) occur as you specify. When you want to make changes, contact Kathy and she can process the changes.
- 4) Donate Using Kent Lutheran's Website. Use the "Make a Donation" button on our webpage www.kentlutheran.org. Pressing this button takes you to a Kent Lutheran screen on a secure server. You are asked to create a giving profile or to login to a profile you have already created. You specify what amounts you want to contribute and if you want to make recurring donations.
